Eat, drink and be merry

When they opened From the Earth (FTE) Brewing Company in 2017, Tim and Lisa Stevens aimed to bring three things to the Roswell community: fine food, craft beer and good music. Almost seven years and a pandemic later, their trendy gastropub continues to exceed expectations.

For five years, the Walton Gas customer has been listed among the top five brewpubs in the nation by readers of USA Today. It has twice claimed the top ranking.

A combination of factors has garnered FTE such a loyal following, says Tim.

"We marry locally sourced, fine cuisine with craft beers, curated wine selections and seasonal craft cocktails — without sacrificing the fun, laid-back environment of a microbrewery," he said.

ON THE menu

Unlike typical "pub grub," FTE's menu features chef-driven seasonal fare made with ingredients sourced from local growers.

"Much of what we serve was harvested only a day before we use it, so it's fresh and perfect," Tim said.

Craft beer lovers will find eight to 12 housemade drafts on tap daily. West Coast-style IPAs Goin' Out West and Symptom of the Universe are the most requested.

MUSIC *affresco*

Music lovers gravitate to FTE to see nationally touring bands perform in the Back Porch Concert Series. The outdoor shows were launched in 2020 when the pandemic limited indoor dining and entertainment.

"We've done more than 110 shows back there," Tim said, pointing to a parking lot only a few steps beyond FTE's rear door.

Walton Gas is a sponsor of the 2024 concerts, including five shows this month. Among the June performers are indie rockers Perpetual Groove (June 1), New Orleans Suspects (June 7) and bluegrass band Shadowgrass (June 8). Poppy Seed Chicken

INGREDIENTS

3 chicken breasts	Topping:
1 can cream of chicken soup	1 stack or about 30 round crackers, crushed
8 ounces sour cream	2 teaspoons poppy seeds
2 teaspoons poppy seeds	1 stick margarine, melted

INSTRUCTIONS

Cook chicken until tender. Chop into small pieces. In mixing bowl, combine cream of chicken soup, sour cream and poppy seeds. Mix well, then set aside. Grease or butter 9x13x2-inch baking dish and layer half of soup mixture in the bottom. Cover with chopped chicken, then top with remainder of soup mixture. Combine ingredients for topping and mix well. Spread over top. Bake at 350 F for 30 minutes.
