1 Lake Lanier Hong Kong Dragon Boat Festival Sept. 12, Gainesville

Georgia's biggest Chinese cultural event features boat races, international cuisine and cultural performances.

2 Hot Air Balloon Festival Sept. 18-19, Buford

A nightly balloon glow and laser show are highlights of this event benefiting the Georgia Mountain Food Bank.

3 Suwanee Fest Sept. 19-20, Suwanee

A parade, Family Fun Zone, arts and crafts vendors and food trucks combine to make this one of the region's largest community celebrations.

4 Decatur Book Festival Oct. 2-3, Decatur

Game Day Starts in the Kitchen

The countdown to football season is on! As you plan your watch parties and tailgates, don't forget the food. These Honey BBQ Chicken Sliders are easy to make, perfect for sharing, and sure to be a hit with fans of all ages.

INGREDIENTS

- 2 pounds shredded cooked chicken
- 1 cup barbecue sauce
- 1/4 cup honey
- 12 Hawaiian slider rolls
- 6 slices cheddar or pepper jack cheese
- 2 tbsp melted butter
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- Dill pickle slices

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat the oven to 350°F.
- Combine the shredded chicken, barbecue sauce and honey in a bowl.
- Slice the slider rolls in half and place the bottom half in a baking dish. Layer with the chicken mixture and cheese, then place the top buns over the sliders. Brush with melted butter and sprinkle with garlic powder. Bake for 12-15 minutes, or until the cheese is melted and the tops are golden brown. Top with dill pickle slices before serving and enjoy!
